

BONSPIEL RULES

Unless otherwise specified, play will be governed by the Rules of the Canadian Curling Association.

All games are **SIX** ends.

The "Free Guard Zone" is **NOT** in effect.

Rinks may change order of play in a new game.

In the event of a tie, each curler will throw one rock (1/2 end). If a tie still exists each skip will throw one rock. The position of the first rock will be recorded and the rock removed. The rock closest to the button wins.

A team not ready to start play at the designated time will be assessed a penalty of one point and one end for every ten minutes of delay. The late team will throw the first rock. A team that is 30 minutes late loses the game by default.

Each team will record their win or loss **IMMEDIATELY** after their game. Record the results of all games played at the lake on the draw sheets in the warm-up hut. Record results of all games played at the Curling Club on the draw sheets in the upstairs lounge.

A member of the Bonspiel Committee will be available at the lake location to assist the curlers with rules and spares.

Bonspiel prizes will be selected in the following order:

3rd and 4th finishers in each draw are the 2 losing semi-finalists. Whichever rink lost to the eventual winner of the draw is awarded 3rd place.

Alcoholic beverages are not permitted at the Lake.

THE DRAW

- There are 64 rinks in the draw
- Each rink is guaranteed a minimum of 4 games and guaranteed that a minimum of 3 of these games will be on the lake (weather permitting).
- There are 4 “events” in the draw.
 - A event (main or championship draw)
 - B event
 - C event
 - D event
- Each game consists of six ends (except if the spiel has to go indoors in which case the games consist of 4 ends).
- Curling commences at the lake at 4 PM Friday afternoon (refer to the enclosed Game Schedule).
- First round losers go to the “B” event and play one game only inside the Curling Club Friday evening.
- The sheets of ice at the Curling Club are designated as 11, 12, 13 and 14.
- First round losers in “B” go to “C”. Second round losers in “A” go to “C”. Second round losers in “B” go to “D”. Third round losers in “A” go to “D”. First round losers in “C” go to “D”.
- Game times – refer to “Bonspiel on the Lake Game Schedule”.
- If bad weather forces the spiel indoors right from the start, the spiel is changed as follows:
 - Each game consists of 4 ends. The “Free Guard Zone” rule is still not in effect.
 - The spiel commences at 3 PM at the Curling Club and games are played almost “around the clock”.
 - Refer to Indoor Contingency Draw Sheets for more information.
 - The last indoor games on Saturday afternoon are scheduled at 5 PM.
 - After dinner at the Community Hall, games resume at 8:30 PM.
 - Some curlers will have to come back to the Curling Club right after dinner. Some can stay on for a bit of dancing but will eventually have to leave the dance early.
- If the spiel starts outdoors and then, because of bad weather, has to be moved indoors, the games that are being played on the lake should be completed. The remaining games then revert to 4 ends and are played in the same order as shown on the original draw sheet.
