

Columbia Valley – Titans Lakeside Tournament - 2009

Tournament Info and Rules and Regulations:



Tournament Headquarters

Headquarters will be at the tent/canopy at the skateboard park.

You are not required to report to headquarters at the beginning of the tournament – just report to the appropriate field.

Roster and Game Sheets

Master Roster Sheets are not required, but you will need a game sheet for each game played. A game sheet with player names and numbers are to be given to the referee before the game. After the game the referee will sign off the game sheet and give it to the field marshal in attendance.

Washrooms and Concession

These are available in the Field House adjacent to the skateboard park. The concession is operated by the Rotary Club with all proceeds going to support Rotary programs.

Spectators, Coaches and Players

Spectators are required to be on the opposite side of the field from the players. While the game is in progress, the manager/coaches and the reserve players must remain in their technical area and may not roam the sidelines. The technical areas are as indicated below.

Max Helmer Field – North Side – farthest from Field House.

Kootenay Savings Field – East Side – farthest from Field House

Laird Field – North Side – Closest to the school

DTSS Field – West Side – Farthest from the School

Substitution

There are no restrictions to the number of substitutes allowed at one time. Players must be at centre prior to asking the Ref/AR for substitution.

Substitutions are always at the discretion of the referee, with the following conditions:

1. Prior to a throw-in by your own team (opposing team may sub at the same time)
2. Prior to a goal kick by either team
3. After a goal by either team
4. After an injury by either team when the referee stops play
5. At the beginning of the second half or overtime periods
6. When the referee issues a caution.

Substituting players must wait for a signal from the referee and then must wait until leaving players arrive at the sideline. Players may depart the field to the nearest sideline or end line but entering players may enter only from center field on the player side of the field.

Duration of Games:

U13 division – 30 minute halves with a 5 minute halftime.

Other divisions – 35 minute halves with a 5 minute halftime.

c) There is no overtime. For pool (round robin) games the tie is recorded. Medal games that end in a tie immediately go to a shoot-out (FIFA rules apply.)

Results

a) 3 points for a win.

b) 1 point for a tie.

c) 0 points for a loss.

d) 1 bonus point for a shut out during a win.

i) If teams are tied after the pool, the tie breaking formula will be as follows:

I. Head to head record between the two teams.

II. Most wins.

III. Least goals against.

IV. Most goals for.

V. Shoot out.

Jersey Colour Conflict

If possible, alternate team colors should accompany the teams to the tournament. If there is a color conflict, a coin flip will decide.

Awards

The top 3 teams in each division will be presented with medals. Medals will be presented at tournament headquarters tent by the skateboard park.

Cautions and Expulsions

A player receiving a direct red card or two cautions in one game will miss the next game.

If a player receives a third caution, the player will be required to leave the game and may be substituted by another player. However, if a player was previously issued a red card due to an accumulation of two cautions in a game, this would not apply.
